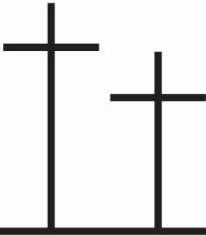

Sermon*Acts 9:1-22*

1 Then Saul, still breathing threats and murder against the disciples of the Lord, went to the high priest **2** and asked letters from him to the synagogues of Damascus, so that if he found any who were of the Way, whether men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem. **3** As he journeyed he came near Damascus, and suddenly a light shone around him from heaven. **4** Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, “Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?” **5** And he said, “Who are You, Lord?” Then the Lord said, “I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. It is hard for you to kick against the goads.” **6** So he, trembling and astonished, said, “Lord, what do You want me to do?” Then the Lord said to him, “Arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.” **7** And the men who journeyed with him stood speechless, hearing a voice but seeing no one. **8** Then Saul arose from the ground, and when his eyes were opened he saw no one. But they led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus. **9** And he was three days without sight, and neither ate nor drank. **10** Now there was a certain disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and to him the Lord said in a vision, “Ananias.” And he said, “Here I am, Lord.” **11** So the Lord said to him, “Arise and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for one called Saul of Tarsus, for behold, he is praying. **12** And in a vision he has seen a man named Ananias coming in and putting his hand on him, so that he might receive his sight.” **13** Then Ananias answered, “Lord, I have heard from many about this man, how much harm he has done to Your saints in Jerusalem. **14** And here he has authority from the chief priests to bind all who call on Your name.” **15** But the Lord said to him, “Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel. **16** For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name’s sake.” **17** And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, “Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.” **18** Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and

was baptized. **19** So when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the disciples at Damascus. **20** Immediately he preached the Christ in the synagogues, that He is the Son of God. **21** Then all who heard were amazed, and said, “Is this not he who destroyed those who called on this name in Jerusalem, and has come here for that purpose, so that he might bring them bound to the chief priests?” **22** But Saul increased all the more in strength, and confounded the Jews who dwelt in Damascus, proving that this Jesus is the Christ.

FROM OUR FINANCE BOARD FUND NEED : Our New Equipment fund currently has an available balance of \$1,600 and we have a need for a new school kitchen refrigerator with an estimated \$6,000 cost. A motion for this purchase will occur at the July quarterly meeting. **BUDGET STATUS:** Our 2024 budget is for \$1,005,000 with expected funding of \$788,000 from donations, \$161,000 from tuition, \$55,000 from the endowment. The budget spreads our expected donations throughout the year based on how donations historically arrived. As of the end of May we had expected \$279,500 in donations, while we have received \$235,000, which is **\$44,500 under expectation**. Our expenses tend to be more evenly distributed throughout the year. At the end of May we had budgeted for \$400,300 in expenses (\$329,600 in personnel expenses, \$60,300 in facilities, and \$10,500 in other expenses), Our actual expenses have been \$377,700 (\$321,300 personnel, \$48,500 facilities, and \$7,800 other), which is \$22,600 less than anticipated. Looking at our income less expenses shows we are behind by \$77,700. (Because of the historical giving pattern and more consistent expenses, we would have expected to be \$55,150 behind at this point of the year).
